

Following the news of the devastating earthquake in Haiti, students of Lab School Unsyiah in Banda Aceh, Indonesia held several events to raise funds for the victims, collecting nearly \$660.

A fundraising Bazaar was held at the school from January 20 – 23. Students prepared and sold finger foods and drinks to their fellow classmates during the mid-morning break. Students also organized a charity car wash volunteered as parking lot attendants, and set out collection boxes on the street of Banda Aceh to raise money from area residents.

The Lab School Unsyiah was established in 2007 in Banda Aceh, Indonesia as a collaboration between USINDO and the Syiah Kuala University to be a model community school, educating students from the areas severely damaged by the 2004 earthquake and tsunami.
